DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. <u>Bond Pre-Qualification</u>

At the March 6th workshop, the board approved the 2023 Bond Steering Committee's recommendation to pursue a zero-mill bond for an August 2023 vote in the estimated about of \$25.5 million. The Business Office has coordinated with bond legal counsel to meet with the Michigan Department of Treasury to review the prequalification application on April 5th. Once the prequalification application is approved by Treasury, the Board will be required to approve the application for final submission. A special

meeting needs to be called for the explicit purpose of approving the prequalification application.

A special meeting needs to be held to approve the 2023 Bond prequalification application for submission. The meeting will be held on April 5, and the April 3 board workshop will be moved to that date.

B. Bond Update

The Christman Company has received bids for Work Categories 01, 02, 05, 07, 10, 11, 12, 14, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25A, 25B, 27A, 27B, 27C, 28, 30 and 40. Bids for each category were received and reviewed by the project team members. The low responsive firms were invited for a formal post bid interview.

The board will vote to approve these bids at its April 3, 2023 board workshop.
