# Childcare and Summer Program



- Operating since **July 6th**
- We have a small childcare program with about 25 children in groups of 10 as well as a small summer program with 15 students. These programs have been running smoothly.
- On Friday, August 7th the Governor mandated masks for childcare for children four and older in common areas (hallways, entering the building). This should reduce the chance of an outbreak even more.
- **We would recommend that we keep childcare and school age care in session on a limited basis because we have proven we can operate it safely.**

# HS Athletics



- High school athletics began outside on **Monday, August 10th.**
- Following all MHSAA guidelines
  - Teams are fairly small and do not intermingle with other teams during practice times.
  - Based on MHSAA guidelines no athletic program or group is allowed to utilize our indoor facilities at this time. Only outdoor practices are permitted.
  - **We would recommend that HS athletics continue.**

# Parent-Tot Program



- The parent-tot program is set to begin on **Friday, September 11th.**
- This program has between 6-8 children.
- **If success continues in the childcare and summer program, we recommend that the parent-tot program starts on time.**

# Tuition Preschool and GSRP



- Scheduled to begin on **Monday, September 14th**, and they are facilitated at Baker as well.
- Preschool class size is about 10-14 kids.
- Between childcare, preschool, and GSRP, we would have about 125 children and 25 staff members in session.
- **If success continues with childcare and our summer program, we would recommend that these programs start on time.**

# Grades DK-1st and 6th-8th



- **If the success of the previous programs continues, we recommend that on Monday, October 5th:**
  - Grades DK, K and 1st grade would operate 5 days a week face-to-face in our cohort instructional plan.
  - Grades 6th-8th would open and operate in the hybrid plan with students in cohorts by grade.
  - Baker would be at full enrollment while Kenwood and Schalm would be at about half enrollment. The middle school, due to the hybrid model, would be operating at half enrollment of our face-to-face students on a daily basis.

# Grades 2nd-5th



- **If success continues in previous programs, we recommend that on Monday, October 26th:**
  - Grades 2nd-5th begin and we would operate in the 5 days a week face-to-face instructional plan.
  - This would bring Kenwood and Schalm to full enrollment of our face-to-face students on a daily basis.



# Grades 9th-12th



- **If success continues in previous programs, we recommend that on Thursday, October 29th:**
  - Grades 9th-12th will operate in the hybrid plan.
  - This would bring the high school, due to the hybrid model, to half enrollment of our face-to-face students, on a daily basis.

*\* Based on the success of previous programs in all buildings, at the semester we will consider moving to a 5 day face-to-face program in the middle school and high school \**
